

MPLN Lift, clean, and replace rules - until further notice!

In the FAIRWAY:

Mud on balls - IF your ball comes to rest with mud on it, you may mark behind the ball, and then lift, clean and replace it at the same position.

Bare or wet conditions - IF your ball comes to rest in bare or squishy wet turf conditions, including areas outlined in blue, you may lift the ball, clean it and place it at the nearest point of relief in the fairway no closer to the hole.

Aeration holes

IF your ball comes to rest in an aeration hole, you may take relief within one club length, no closer to the hole.

In the BUNKER:

IF your ball comes to rest in **standing water** or if your stance would be in standing water, you may take relief within the bunker no closer to the hole.

In a bunker, if your ball comes to rest in a **footprint or other unraked area**, you may take relief within the bunker no closer to the hole.
